

# PEST PROOFING

## Checklist



#### Inspect and seal entry points:

Conduct a thorough inspection of your home's exterior for gaps, cracks, and openings. Seal any potential entry points, including around windows, doors, and utility penetrations

#### Trim tree branches and shrubs:

Trim back trees and shrubs that may be touching or close to your home. This prevents pests like rodents from using them

as a bridge to enter your house.

#### Secure the trash cans:

Ensure that garbage bins are tightly sealed to discourage pests such as rodents and raccoons from foraging for food near your home.

# Clean gutters:

Clear gutters of leaves and debris to prevent standing water,

which can attract pests like mosquitoes and termites.

## Store firewood away:

If you use firewood, store it at a distance from your home, as it can be a hiding place for pests. Keep it elevated and away from the ground.



## Tidy up attic and crawlspace:

Check attics and crawlspaces for signs of pests. Ensure proper <u>insulation and ventilation to discourage pests from nesting.</u>



#### Check and maintain screens:

Inspect window and door screens for holes or tears. Repair or replace damaged screens to keep out insects like spiders and flies.



Store food items in airtight containers to prevent attracting \_\_\_\_ pantry pests like ants, beetles, and rodents.

#### Regular Vacuuming:

Vacuum frequently, especially in areas where crumbs or food particles may accumulate. This helps eliminate food sources for pests
